Application Guidelines

Rotary is a worldwide organization of business and professional leaders that provides humanitarian service, encourages high ethical standards in all vocations, and helps build goodwill and peace in the world. Approximately 1.2 million Rotarians belong to more than 32,000 clubs in more than 200 countries and geographical areas.

Local Rotary Criteria & Priorities

Grants are made for projects, programs or events that meet the following priorities & Criteria:

- **Population & Geographical considerations** – Projects, events and programs that promote and support Children in the Greater Manchester area.
- **When and How to Apply** - Annual application deadline is March 15th. Annual grants are reviewed and distributed each spring. Intermittent requests may be accepted and dispersed at the discretion of the Board. Please submit requests only once annually. Applications can be mailed to Queen City Rotary Club, P.O. Box 3032, Manchester, NH 03105
- **Organizational Status** - Requests made by organizations for donations will be duly considered from any legitimate tax-exempt organization under section 501 of the IRS code, or any local, state or regional organization located within the state of New Hampshire, which supports a charitable purpose or that demonstrates a commitment to enhance the quality of life in the region.
- **Grant Award Range** - Grant awards typically range between \$500 to \$1500.
- **Additional Collateral** – Additional information and/or collateral is welcome but not necessary
- **Exclusions** - The Club generally does not support:
 - Religious or political purposes,
 - Deficit reduction or to support an activity that has already taken place, or
 - Support of general operating or administrative expenses.
